5. Coach's Corner

- a) Room Change: Band to inherit Football RM 171 as of 7/1/18. District safety/risk management decided on change due to band students practicing outside of school boundaries and their safety is the main priority.
- b) Summer Camp: Have low Freshman count. Approximately 27-28 players attending. Some have paid but have not been attending. In need of 1 more Freshman Coach. JV and V staff set. Over all great camaraderie and energy amongst boys in weight room and on the field. Off to a great start.
- c) Dead Period beginning 7/9/18 will have weight training on MWTH for all levels. AM Time TBD.
- d) New Racks and Bars for weight room provided by CHHS
- e) Script Fundraiser: Parent brought up another fundraiser where GC are purchased from specific store and 15% goes back to the program. Natalie Morgan to follow up with and get all information on how this fundraiser works.
- f) Injuries: Parent brought up concern for a few athletes getting same injury. A possible overuse injury that may be from over training. Coach insured parent that players health is important. Players will need to follow what is directed, for example, rest, ice, stretching, massage therapy and see Athletic Trainer Gia. Suggestion for addition of YOGA/stretching added into the program regimen. Coach to look into addition for players program for injury prevention.
- g) Parent suggestion of a "motivational pep rally" to get players ready before the Battle of the Bone game. Possibility of having band or music or any other motivational ideas that will pump boys up. Coach will look into possibilities for this idea.
- h) Parent brought up schedule conflict of Varsity Surf City Challenge on 7/14/18 is on same day as ACT test. Coach will have to research this information.
